Audition process

1. Fill out an Audition Form and on the Production Schedule please indicate days/times the actor auditioning is not available. **Tech Week (final week of rehearsal) and performances are mandatory.**
2. Hand our audition volunteers your completed Audition Form and Production Schedule for them to confirm everything is filled out and to address any further questions about your form and conflicts.
3. Please be seated and wait for further instructions from the director. Good luck!
4. Call backs: the Director will instruct when and what time they will be held, as well as how actors will be notified if needed for call backs.

Parents & guardians: *To minimize distractions, please leave the building when auditions begin and return for your actor at the end of the audition process (1½ to 2 hours). Thanks for your cooperation!*

Show information

- Approximately 10 - 15 actors will be cast in this play. The cast list will be posted on our facebook page (facebook.com/CAPTheatre) by Sunday, May 19th (if we have to have a 2nd round of auditions, we will put a post on Facebook letting everyone know). It will be posted on our website (www.capttheatre.org) shortly after.
- Actors entering the 7th grade through age 21 will be cast in this production.
- A mandatory Parent Meeting will be at 6:00 pm on Monday May 20th, 2019 @ Haines Park. (Parents only).
- An activity fee of \$25 is required for each actor cast in this play.
- All actors must supply their own white short sleeve undershirt and neutral color shorts to wear under costumes as well as basic black flats for shoes (simple slip-on shoes with a sole and no adornments).
- Rehearsals will generally be on Mondays, Tuesdays & Thursdays from 6-8:30 pm, and on Saturdays from 9am-noon. Rehearsals may also be scheduled on Wednesday evenings or Sunday afternoons/evenings, if additional work is needed or due to Holiday scheduling.
- Electronic devices, including cell phones, are not allowed during rehearsals or performances. We recommend leaving them at home or in the car.
- In case of weather-related rehearsal cancellations, make-up rehearsals may be scheduled for the entire cast on originally non-scheduled days.
- Every attempt will be made to work around agreed-upon conflicts, but unscheduled conflicts won't be accepted and may result in re-casting a part. Conflicts **do** affect casting decisions; if an actor has too many conflicts, they may not be cast in the show, regardless of skill level.
- Tech Week is Saturday July 20th - Wednesday July 24th, 2019. Mandatory rehearsal is each and every day from at least 6 pm to no later than 8:30 pm.
- Performances will be July 25, 26, 27 and 28th on Thursday, Friday and Saturday at 7 pm and Sunday at 2:00 pm. Actors are expected at the theatre one hour prior. **All performances are mandatory.**
- Parents/Guardians are required to volunteer during 1 rehearsals and 1 performances, at a minimum.
- Parents/Guardians are asked to donate water or soda, which will be served at intermission during show performances. You will receive a donation confirmation for water or soda, which you can use for tax purposes.
