

## Class Act Productions and COVID-19 As of January 5, 2022

CAP's Policy for COVID-19 is based on CDC regulations and our desire to protect all involved as best we can. When getting involved in any "in-person" activity with others there is no 100% guarantee protection from becoming infected. Our policy is subject to change as CDC regulations change. Please read these expectations before attending any "in-person" event or activity held at CAP Theatre.

- Everyone must wear masks, covering nose and mouth, at all times while inside the theatre unless on stage when young actors are present. The only exception is if there is a medical reason that you cannot wear a mask, you may participate, understanding the risks. Masks will be provided but you are encouraged to use your own. If a mask break is needed a student can socially distance and stand by the door while being able to be seen and supervised by a responsible adult.
- All visitors of the theatre must wash hands often and use the hand sanitizer provided or you may bring your own. Please make sure that your hand sanitizer is at least 60% alcohol.
- Any volunteers or students that are having any signs of illness must stay home. You will not attend any "in-person" activities, unless testing negative for COVID-19. If you test positive for COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status, you should isolate for 5 days and if you are asymptomatic or your symptoms are resolving (without a fever for 24 hours) you may return and be required to wear a mask at all times in the theatre, even on stage for 10 days
- If you are not fully vaccinated\* and have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, we ask that you not attend for 5 days and test negative to return. You will also need to wear mask at all times in the theatre, even on stage for additional 5 days.
- If you are fully vaccinated\* and have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 and have no symptoms, you do not need to quarantine, but must wear mask at all times in the theatre, even on stage for 10 days. If symptoms occur, individuals should immediately quarantine until a negative test confirms symptoms are not attributable to COVID-19.
- After each event/activity, all surfaces, objects used, and bathrooms will be disinfected.

\*Fully vaccinated means one of the following things:

- You have been boosted
- You completed the primary series of the Pfizer vaccines within the last 5 months
- You completed the primary series of the Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months
- You completed the primary series of the J&J vaccine within the last 2 months
